
The 7 respeggt rules

Requirements for rearing farms






No male chicks may be killed. The male chicks of respeggt flocks must be reared until they are at least 10 weeks old and may only be slaughtered once they have reached this age and a minimum weight of 1.3 kg.

All employees must know and follow the respeggt rules for the rearing of respeggt chicks.






The respeggt chicks must **never** be mixed with conventional chicks.



The **respeggt flock passport** must be visibly displayed on the **entrance door of the rearing barn** of the respeggt chicks.




The respeggt flock passport must be delivered **together with** the respeggt pullets to the down-stream laying hen farms.





All relevant documentation, such as delivery notes, transport documents and invoices, must always be marked with the reference **respeggt FoCC** (Free of Chick Culling) or with the respeggt document stamp.





Employees of **respeggt group** may visit the rearing farm at any time.
